# Awards

## High Point Western/English Awards

Points will be tabulated on a nine (9) point system. Example: In a class of nine (9) or more, first place receives nine (9) points; second place gets eight (8) points; etc. In a class of five (5), first place receives five (5) points; second place gets four (4) points; etc. Awards will be determined on total points earned. **Halter is not required –however, Halter points will** count towards the High Point Awards (Amateur Halter for Novice Amateur and Select High Points and Youth Halter for Novice Youth High Point). All Amateur and Youth Awards are 1 horse/1rider.

Roping classes do not count toward the High Point Western/English awards, however barrels, poles, stakes, and cowhorse do.

If you do not plan on staying til the end of the show, please have someone pick up your award—they will not be shipped. High Points will receive a quilted saddle carrier in the following divisions: **Amateur Western/English, Novice Amateur Western/English, Select Western/English, Youth Western/English, Novice Youth Western/English**.

## High Point Roping Awards

Points will be tabulated on a nine (9) point system. Awards will be determined on total points earned. **Halter is not required –however, Halter points will** count towards awards. All Amateur and Youth Awards are 1 horse/1 rider. Horse or Horse/Exhibitor are **not** required to enter every class in the category they are competing in. For example, a Youth Roper does not have to exhibit in all 4 roping classes; Calf Roping, Breakaway, Heading & Heeling to be eligible for that award. Checks will be made out to the owner of the horse in the Open division and the exhibitor in Amateur division unless otherwise specified. Please bring the social security # or tax ID # of the winner when checks are picked up.

## Circuit Awards

Circuit Awards will be awarded in every AQHA approved class. Halter is **not required** for these awards. You must show the last day the class shows. Points will be tabulated on a nine point system.

## High Point Select Exhibitor

An AQHA Championship buckle will be awarded to the High Point Select exhibitor. Points are determined on a 9 pt. basis. Halter is not required.

# Show Entry Info

---

## PreRegistration

Save time by sending in your information ahead of time! A copy of the horse's AQHA registration, the exhibitor's current AQHA membership card and a current (1 yr.) Coggins test is required to preregister and enter. You will not be allowed to show without a current Coggins. **Include copies of these items with the Pre-Registration Master Sheet.** You are not required to Pre-Register, but who wants to stand in line?

Mail pre-registrations to Tulsa Holiday Circuit, P.O. Box 1004, Stillwater, OK 74076. You may also fax your PreRegistration to 405.743.0870. Do not mail to Stillwater after June 20th, bring to show.

### Working Cowhorse Exhibitors

Cowhorse exhibitors must pre-register and enter classes by June 22nd to reserve fresh cattle. Entries will be accepted at the show, but fresh cattle will not be guaranteed.

## Payment

Cash, check, Mastercard, Visa, or Discover. All bills must be settled by end of show. Tabs run only if an open, signed check is left at show office. Returned checks will be assessed a \$25.00 fee. **Unpaid bills are reported to the AQHA.**

## Rules of the Show

---

- ◆ **NO REFUNDS ON SCRATCHES** unless scratched at the *show office* 3 classes prior to class being scratched.
- ◆ **All AWARDS and MONIES** must be picked up at the show *or be forfeited—they will not be shipped.*
- ◆ Oklahoma state law requires every horse entering the grounds possess a current (1 yr.) Coggins. You will not be allowed to show without a current Coggins.
- ◆ AQHA rules will be strictly enforced by show personnel.
- ◆ Each contestant must pay their own entry fee.
- ◆ Working order in individually worked classes will be drawn for. **YOU MUST GO IN ORDER.** You must ride in your heat in rail classes. Working orders will be announced and posted.
- ◆ Tie breakers for all awards: 1st - Most number of classes shown pertaining to that award; 2nd - Most number first places, second places, etc.; 3rd - Flip a coin.
- ◆ Patterns will be posted near the entrance of each arena.
- ◆ No exhibition runs will be allowed.
- ◆ Youth classes will receive ribbons, with First Place awarded caps or T shirts.
- ◆ Gate calls will be strictly enforced.
- ◆ All exhibitors must have current 2010 AQHA *INDIVIDUAL* memberships to compete. Memberships can be purchased at the show office.
- ◆ Any damage to stalls or barns will be charged to the registered occupant.
